## TREE DESCRIPTIONS

### SHRUBS

*Plant 4-8 feet apart, with 6-8 feet between rows.*

**Chokeberry, Glossy Black** – White spring flowers, black berries & red fall foliage. Plants will spread by suckers but are not overly aggressive. Drought tolerant. Mature height 3-6' tall.

**Cranberry, American High bush** – Large white cluster blooms in June. Bright red fruit in early fall. Prefers well-drained, moist soils, partial shade to full sun. Mature height 8-12' tall.

**Dogwood, Gray** – Very adaptable. Slower growing. Mature height 10-15' tall.

**Dogwood, Redosier** – Fast growing shrub, soil-sand through clay, and full sun. Medium to dark green leaves and red stems. Produces berries for wildlife, and is good for wetter sites. Mature height 6-12' tall.

**Indigo, False** – Grows well in moist soils, full sun. Bluish-purple flowers, blue-green foliage. Good wildlife cover. Mature height 8-12' tall.

**Juneberry** – Moderate growth rate, soils-sand through sandy clay, and full to part sun. Fruit produced is sweet and can be eaten or used for jellies. Mature height 4-6' tall.

**Lilac, Common** – Moderate growth rate, soils-sandy loam through clay loam, and full sun. Green foliage, lavender spring flower. Mature height 10-15' tall.

**Nannyberry** – Clusters of small white flowers in the spring. Red fall foliage color. Lower branches root where they touch the ground. Matures 10-14' tall.

---

### DECIDUOUS TREES

*Plant 8-16 feet apart, with 10-16 feet between rows.*

**Birch, Paper** – Reddish brown bark matures chalky to creamy white. Single stem, rapid growth rate. Low drought tolerance; full sun. Favorite deer browse. Mature height 70' tall.

**Birch, River** – Fast growing, soils-sand through clay, and full to partial sun. Mature height 30-50' tall.

**Cherry, Black** – Dark green leaves which turn to yellow or red in fall. White spring flowers; edible fruit. Prefers moist, rich, well-drained soil. Full sun. Mature height 50-60' tall. Alternative species for green ash.

**Hackberry** – Fast growing, soils-sandy loam through silty clay, and full to partial sun. Mature height 50-75' tall.

**Linden, American** - Sun or partial shade. Tan blossoms, yellow fall color. Mature height 35" tall.

**Maple, Red** – Fast growing, prefers sand through clay and does well in sun to partial shade. Fall foliage usually red but may be yellow or orange. Matures 50-70' tall.

**Maple, Silver** – Fast-growing. Graceful form. Tolerates partial shade. Very hardy. The fall color is gold. Prefers moist or moderately drained soils. Matures 60-90' tall.

**Maple, Sugar** – Slow growing, soils-sandy loam through silty loam, and full sun to shade. Has bright green leaves that turn yellow to scarlet in the fall. Mature height 50-75' tall.

**Oak, Bur** – Slow growing, soils-sand through clay, and full sun. Mature height 60-100' tall.

**Oak, Red** – Fastest grower of the oaks. Dense.

Lustrous foliage. Red fall color. Leaves hang on tree into winter. Mature height 60-80' tall.

**Oak, White** – Glossy leaves with white undersides turn purple-red in fall. Prefers well-drained acidic soil. Partial to full sun. Excellent for wildlife planting. Mature height 50-80' tall.

**Walnut, Black** – Fast growing, prefers sandy loam through clay loam and full sun. Mature height 70-100' tall.

---

### CONIFERS

*Pine-plant 6-12 feet apart, with 10-12 feet between rows.*

*Spruce-plant 14-16 ft apart, with 14-16 ft between rows.*

**Juniper, Eastern Red Cedar** – Slow growing, soils-sand through clay, and full sun. Mature height 40-50' tall.

**Pine, Norway (Red)** – Minnesota State Tree. Fast growing, soils-sand through silty clay, and full to partial sun. Mature height 75-100' tall.

**Pine, Scotch** – Grayish-yellow branches. Short, rigid, bluish-green needles. Very picturesque. Hardy, rapid-growing pine. Prefers sandy loam or heavier soils. Will grow on very poor ground. Mature height 25-50' tall.

**Pine, White** – Fast-growing, soils-loamy sand through clay loam, and full to partial sun. Mature height 75-100' tall.

**Spruce, Black Hills** – Moderate growth rate, soils-loamy sand through clay. Will tolerate full to partial sun. Mature height 30-50' tall.

**Spruce, Colorado** – A slow to moderately fast growing, short needled evergreen. Prefers heavier soils, full sun, average moisture, and clean cultivation. Color varies from deep green to silver blue. Mature height 30-65' tall.

**Spruce, Norway** – Fastest growing spruce, soils-sandy loam through clay in full sun. Mature height 80' tall.

**Spruce, White** – Moderate growth rate, soils-loam through clay in sun through shade. Mature height 50-75' tall.

**Tamarack** – Small to medium-sized deciduous conifer. Wildlife use the tree for food & nesting. Grows best on moist but well-drained loamy soils. Intolerant of shade. Needles turn yellow in the fall.

### SHELTERS, MATS, & FERTILIZER

**VisPore Tree Mat** – A 3'X 3' mat that kills weeds by blocking sunlight. Five staples per mat included.

**Right Start Fertilizer Packets** – Time-release, biodegradable "tea bag" of nutrients you simply drop in the planting hole.

**Marking Flags** – Flags help you keep track of young trees in grassy areas.
