

# Potter Shoreline



**Project:** Shoreline stabilization planting on 150 feet of shoreline along Lake Marion. The project included the installation of coir biolog, erosion control blanket, and use of native vegetation. Approximately 700 native perennials and 28 shrubs were used to vegetate the shoreline.

**Costs:** The material and plant costs for the project was \$2,268.42.

**Funding:** Dakota County SWCD provided design and construction oversight and Community Conservation Cost Share funding in the amount of \$1,134.21. The City of Lakeville donated coir biolog for the project.
