- Chris Nielsen, Farmington, (6<sup>th</sup> year) represents District IV (Townships of Castle Rock, Eureka, Greenvale, Sciota, and Waterford, along with a small portion of Northfield).
- Joe Meyers, Hampton, (18<sup>th</sup> year) represents District V (Cities of Hampton, Miesville, New Trier, and Randolph and the Townships of Douglas, Hampton, and Randolph).

The following officers were elected: Scott Holm Chair, Chris Nielsen Vice-Chair, Joe Meyers Treasurer, Scott Norstad Secretary, and Kevin Chamberlain Public Relations and Information Officer.

Holm said, "The Board looks forward to the coming year to implement effective conservation programs in both urban and agricultural areas of Dakota County."
