VII. AMENDMENT PROCEDURES

It is the intention of the Gun Club Lake Watershed Management Organization (GCLWMO) to have this water management plan reviewed and approved by the Board of Water and Soil Resources (BWSR). Once approved, no significant changes to this plan can be facilitated without the approval of the proposed revisions by the BWSR. Significant changes to the GCLWMO plan shall be made known to the following parties:

1. The Cities of Eagan, Inver Grove Heights and Mendota Heights.
2. The Metropolitan Council.
3. Minnesota Board of Water and Soil Resources and all review Agencies as set forth in Minnesota Rules Chapter 8410.
4. A public meeting must be held to explain the amendments and publish a legal notice of this public meeting twice at least seven (7) days and 14 days prior to the date of the public meeting.

Following notification of the above parties, they shall have 45 days to comment on the proposed revisions. Failure to respond within 45 days constitutes approval.

Minor changes to the plan shall be defined as recodification of the plan, revision of a procedure meant to streamline administration of the plan, clarification of the intent of a policy, the inclusion of additional data not requiring interpretation, or any other action that will not adversely affect the member communities or diminish the GCLWMO's ability to achieve the plan goals or implementation program. Adjustment to subwatershed boundaries will be considered minor changes, provided that the change will have no significant impact on the rate or quality in which storm water runoff is discharged from the WMO boundaries. Minor changes to this plan can be made by the staff of the GCLWMO with the above-noted public notification process. This plan will be in effect through December, 2012 unless significant changes to the plan are deemed necessary prior to that date.
